

A MESSAGE FROM MRS WALSH

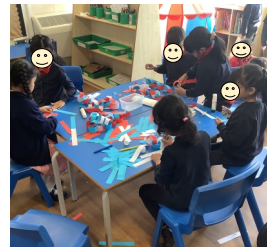
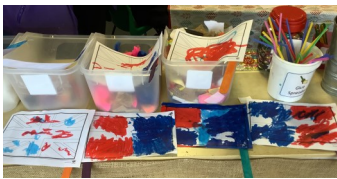
