Superwiggles 2023

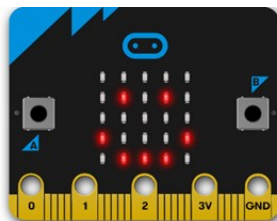


Superwiggles has returned to Palfrey Infant School this term for 4 weeks. Parents and Children really enjoy the sessions.

ATTENDANCE UPDATE:

Reception - Year 2: 90.7% attendance, Year 1- Year 2: 91.9% attendance.

National expectation for attendance is 96%. As you can see we are well below that expectation at present, let's work together to improve this. Parents can send pupils in, having given 'Calpol' etc as long as parents feel they are well enough to be in school.

I would encourage using vitamin supplements to boost the children's immune systems. Ask the local pharmacy for recommendations.
