The class with the most stickers at the end of the term win a box of chocolates!

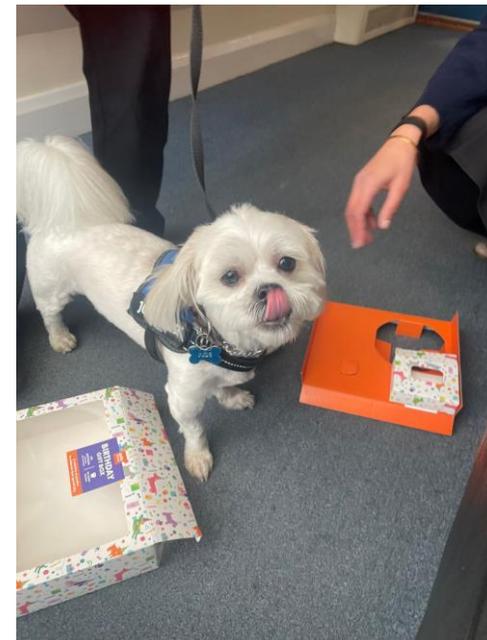


Jude is 4 Years Old

Jude's Birthday was on Tuesday 2nd May.

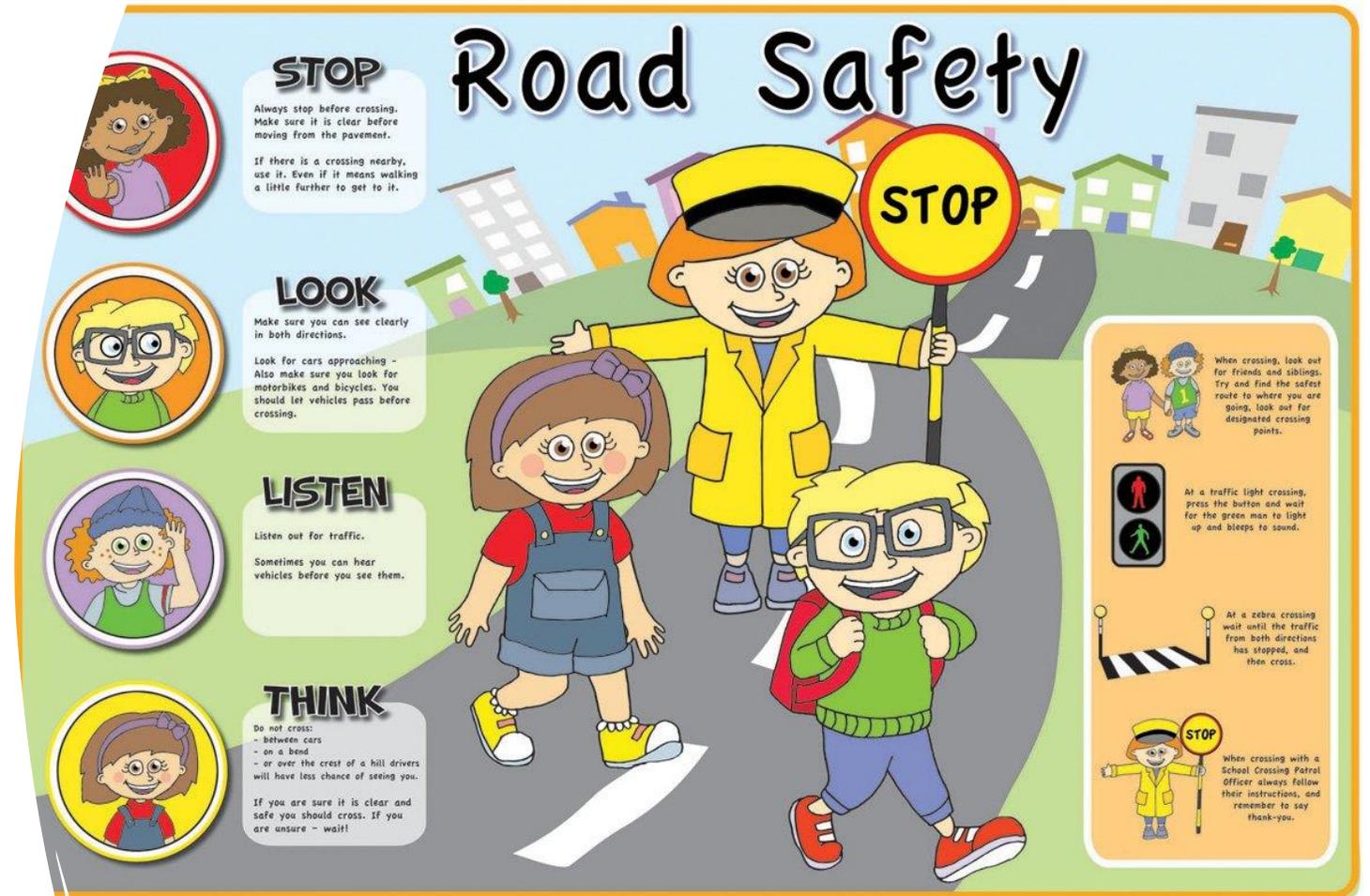
The Birthday boy received a special present from the Office Team and enjoyed his treats and special Pawsome Birthday Card

New September Pupils 2025

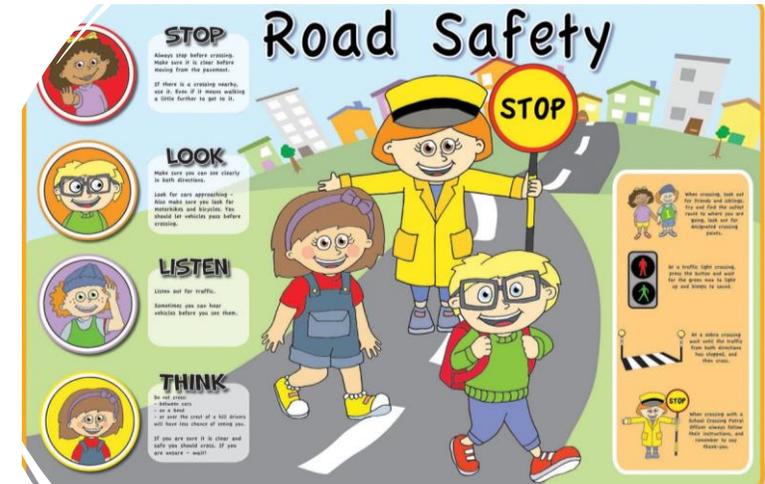


- We are looking forward to seeing some new children in September and we are holding special meetings with the Head Teacher and Teachers to ensure a smooth transition.
