Home School Agreement

At Palfrey infant school we believe that children:

1. Attend school regularly and be on time. Attendance target is 96%
2. Show good manners and courtesy to each other and adults.
3. Behave in a manner that does not threaten safety of others.
4. Respect the property of others and of the school.
5. Follow the school/ class rules.

The school will:

1. Provide a safe, secure environment in which children can learn and develop.
2. Encourage children to adopt a healthy lifestyle.
3. Care, support and respect all individuals.
4. Praise and reward effort and good behaviour.
5. Encourage children to be responsible for their own actions.
6. Contact parents where necessary
7. Listen.
8. Set attainable targets, which are shared with parents.
9. Inform parents of the child’s progress regularly.
10. Challenge and support parents when attendance is below 92%.

The Child will:

1. Come to school everyday ready to show good learning
2. Show good behaviour and behaviours for leaning.
3. Take pride in their own work.
4. Show kindness and respect for each other and all adults within school
5. Behave sensibly, demonstrating good manners and consideration towards other people.
6. Take responsibility for their own belongings and respect other people.
7. Bring their book bag to school every day.

The Family will:

1. Encourage by praise, good work and behaviour.
2. Ensures their child comes to school on time by a known adult.
3. Ensures their child wears school uniform, labelled with name, sensible shoes and no jewellery.
4. Ensures their child comes to school with their reading book and book bag.
5. Ensure that absence is due only to illness and that school is informed on the first day of illness.
6. Not attend holidays during term time.
7. Support the child in home work and other opportunities for home learning.
8. Wear correct PE kit on PE day.
