


Walsall School Nursing Service

The School Nursing Service supports children and young people aged four (in full time school) up to the age of 19 years old who attend school or are home educated in the Walsall borough.

The service is provided by a team lead by school nurses who are qualified nurses with specialist training in public health for children, young people and families. The service delivers the Healthy Child programme 5-19.

School Nurses are skilled in identifying health problems or concerns and to provide early support. We offer advice and support on a wide range of health issues. We can provide confidential support to older children and young people.

Every school in Walsall has access to a School Nurse.
