All children can also bring a waterbottle with them



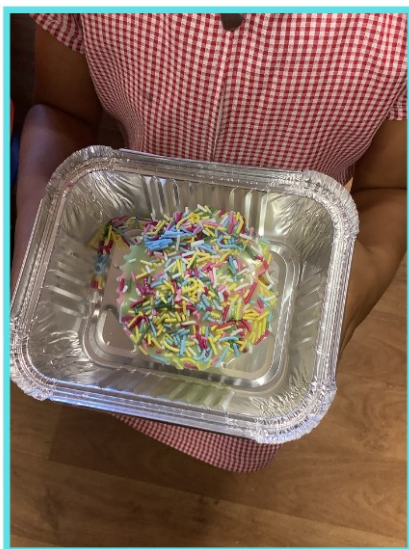
